Felixstow Reserve showcases some of the rich cultural history of the Kurna people – the traditional owners of the Adelaide Plains on which the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters is located. The local waterways, landforms, features and living things continue to be significant and important to Kurna people today.

Kurna traditional seasonal activities and dreaming stories are connected to the River Torrens/**Karrawirra Pari** (red gum-forest river) and to Fourth Creek/**Mariyarta Pari** (east-country river), which originates in the Mount Lofty Ranges above Morialta Conservation Park and ends its journey at this Reserve.

# Welcome to Felixstow Reserve

## Nature Play

The Nature Play area includes boulders, logs and other natural elements for sitting, stepping and climbing. The small play structures are inspired by a wathuwardli (branch hut) and reference the camps the Kurna people created on the embankments of the River Torrens/Karrawirra Pari.

## Pavilion & Recreation Space

The pavilion provides shelter, toilets and picnic tables. Basketball, netball, bocce, and BBQ facilities are located nearby.

## Outdoor Fitness

A one kilometre running loop circles the Reserve and connects to the River Torrens Linear Park Trail.

## The Canoe Scar Tree

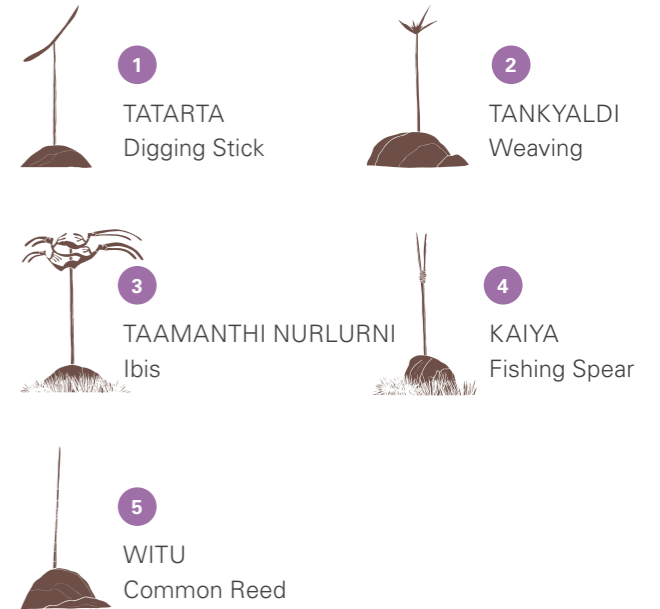
A large River Red Gum (*Eucalyptus camaldulensis*) located on the banks of Fourth Creek/Marriyarta Pari is an important historical link to the traditional use of the area. The tree was used to make a yuku (bark canoe) over 200 years ago.

## Wetlands

The wetlands were built by the Eastern Region Alliance as part of the Waterproofing Eastern Adelaide Project.

## Cultural Markers

Five (5) Kurna cultural markers located throughout the Reserve provide an insight into the Kurna beliefs, traditions and culture. The markers were designed by Paul Munaitya Herzich, a Kurna/Ngarrindjeri landscape architect, public and visual artist from South Australia.
